Pathlab are continuing to invest resources in ensuring specimen integrity throughout the reporting process. Primary specimen labelling is now our largest source of error within the reporting pathway.

We see a steady stream of mislabelled specimens.

The consequences of a labelling error not being detected or resolved can be disastrous.

I would like to remind everyone about our specimen labelling policies.

If there is any risk of confusion as to who a sample belongs to, all involved samples will be regarded as unsatisfactory and a repeat test will be required.

On occasion when a specimen is incompletely labelled and all other aspects of identification and tracking are intact, we may allow identification to be completed by the original requestor only.

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
