COVID-19 Community Testing

Effective 2nd June, Pathlab will be ready to collect COVID-19 swabs. The procedure is as follows:

Tier 1 – Virtual Assessment by GP:

- All Pathlab rooms that are currently open will be collecting swabs click link for up to date collection room information <u>https://www.pathlab.co.nz/locations</u>.
- The clinician emails the request forms to the dedicated email address <u>requestforms@pathlab.co.nz</u>.
 - stating the patient NHI and room the patient will attend in the subject line, and
 - ensuring the current phone number for patient is on the form.
- No signature is required if ePath form is used (process as detailed below).
- Please do NOT send a physical copy as well.
- The patient will then be contacted for an appointment time.
- Some swabs are likely to be done with patients remaining in their vehicles, depending on the facility location.

Tier 2 – Collected at GP Practice:

Please note: PPE and Covid-19 collection packs must be ordered from <u>THIS FORM</u> for Tauranga hospital stores. The pack will include instructions for your collection, packaging and sending to Pathlab.

- Swab collected as per collection pack instructions.
- Swab double bagged and labelled with COVID-19 sticker.
- Pathlab form in outer pocket of bag.
- Swab can be stored in standard chilly bin. (Swabs should ideally be refrigerated if unable to be sent to the laboratory immediately but will be okay at ambient temperature for up to 48 hours).
- Any other samples (e.g throat swab) taken at the same time as a COVID-19 swab must be sent in a separate bag with a separate form please.

Laboratory Form within PMS

The following details must be recorded:

- Site of swab -Nasopharyngeal/Oropharyngeal.
- Date of onset of symptoms.
- Presence of fever, cough, SOB, sore throat, loss of smell/taste, any other symptoms.
- Travel History days since return.
- Contact with COVID Patients Y/N
- HealthCare Worker Y/N
