# **COVID-19 REQUEST FORMS**

Currently a variety of COVID request forms are in existence – CBAC, sentinel investigation etc. This 'old stock' of COVID request forms do not have all the relevant information on it e.g. GP / GP practice information, hence results cannot be sent to the relevant clinician.

So please:

- Remove all 'old stock' of COVID request forms
- All COVID-19 requests should now be made on the usual GP generated request form and **must state** whether patient is Asymptomatic or Symptomatic (details of symptoms are not required).

Please see request form / swab requirements as follows:

Each swab/request form must be individually bagged as some testing is done at Waikato hospital laboratory and some testing is done at Pathlab.

## **COVID-19 TESTING**

### Specimen requirement: One Nasopharyngeal swab

#### NASOPHARYNGEAL SWAB COLLECTION

- Wear PPE: mask, gloves, eye protection, gown
- Rest back of patient's head against wall (or car headrest)
- Insert swab <u>4-5 cm</u> into nose in horizontal direction.
- Rotate swab 3 x each way

#### **COVID-19 swab packs**

- Each pack contains one swab and one tube
- Swab is **flexible**
- Tube contains virus transport medium (VTM or VTF)

Actual swabs/tubes may vary slightly from those pictured





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- There is no need to double bag COVID-19 specimens
- COVID-19 swabs must be bagged separately from other laboratory specimens such as bloods and other swabs, and have a separate laboratory request form
- COVID-19 swabs will routinely be tested for SARS-CoV-2 virus only
- Normal courier services apply
