Haemochromatosis Screening

Introduction:

If Hereditary Haemochromatosis (HH) is suspected, the diagnosis can be confirmed by blood tests.

The screening protocol is dependent on presentation / family history. Consensus recommended investigations.

First degree relative with HH:

Fasting iron & saturation

Ferritin

Haemochromatosis Gene testing

No family history.

Fasting iron & saturation*

Ferritin*

If a request for Haemochromatosis screening is received without specific request for *Haemochromatosis Gene testing*, the following will only be performed.

- Fasting iron & saturation
- Ferritin
