## Pre-requisite Clinical Details for Infectious Serology Testing

The policy of having clinical details as a pre-requisite for Infectious Serology testing is now becoming established and awareness throughout the region is increasing. A full audit of the policy will be performed before the end of the year.

There are however a couple of issues that we have come across that need to be addressed:

- Serological testing relating to employee/student screening, insurance medicals, immigration medicals or pre-travel screening. This type of testing is not funded by the DHB. Therefore patient payment is required before laboratory testing for these reasons can be performed.
- Serological testing for Hepatitis A & B immunity. A lot of testing for
  Hepatitis A & B immunity falls into the above (non-DHB funded) category. If
  there is a clear 'clinical' reason for testing for immunity to Hepatitis A
  and/or B, it must be stated on the request form. Clinical details such as
  "pre-vaccine", "post-vaccine", or "immunity check" without further
  supporting details will not be deemed acceptable.
