

FAECES FOR OCCULT BLOOD PATIENT INSTRUCTIONS

In order to complete the test, your Doctor has requested 1 faeces specimen to be collected.

It is important to follow these instructions carefully to ensure your test results are accurate.

Preparation

- Obtain a faecal specimen collection pack from a laboratory collection room.
- Avoid specimen collection:
 - During menstruation. Wait until 3 days after your period has finished.
 - While you have bleeding haemorrhoids.
 - While you have blood in your urine.
- Some drugs such as aspirin and other pain killers may cause gastric irritation resulting in minor bleeding from the stomach. If in doubt about whether to stop these, consult your doctor.

Collection Procedure

- 1. Label the container with your full name, date of birth and time & date of collection.
- 2. Pass the specimen into the clean plastic container provided.
- 3. Using the scoop attached to the lid of the sample bottle, collect a specimen of faeces. (Enough to fill 1/3 to 1/2 of the container)
- 4. Take care not to mix the specimen with urine or toilet water.
- 5. Bring the specimen to a laboratory on the **same day** as it is collected.
- 6. Ensure a copy of the request form is with the specimen.
