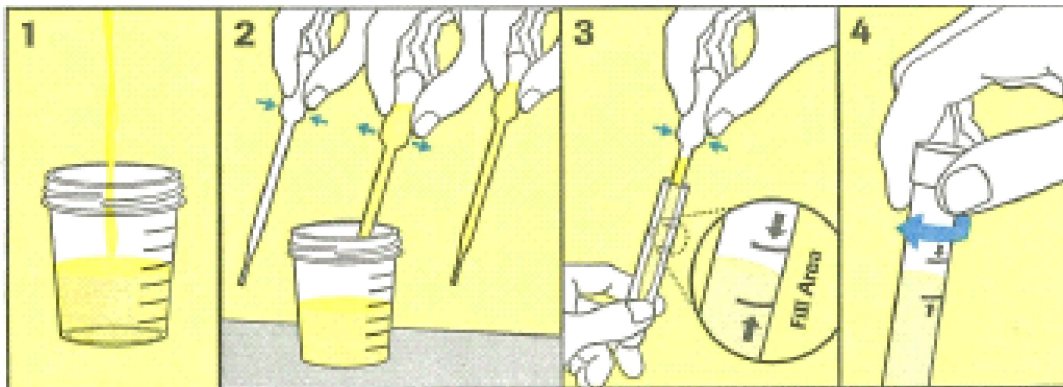


CHLAMYDIA URINE (FIRST CATCH URINE) PATIENT INFORMATION SHEET

It is important to follow these instructions carefully to ensure your test results are accurate.

- a) Wash hands.
- b) Use container provided by laboratory.
- c) Catch first 10 mL in dish only – remainder into toilet.
- d) Transfer urine using pipette provided so that the urine fill level is between the two black lines. Screw lid on tightly – see diagram.
- e) Label container with surname, first name, date of birth, time and date of collection, put in specimen bag (seal the top), request form into outside pocket and deliver to laboratory as soon as possible.
- f) If specimen cannot be transported to the Laboratory immediately they can be stored in the fridge overnight.
