

CHLAMYDIA / GONORRHOEA URINE (First Catch Urine)

It is important to follow these instructions carefully to ensure your test results are accurate.

Preparation:


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Do not pass urine for at least one hour prior to specimen collection.

Open the Urine Preservative Transport kit and remove the tube from the packaging.

Collection Procedure:

- 1. Collect only the first 10-30 ml of urine passed into the collection dish provided
- 2. Remove the screw cap from the tube, **tube must remain in an upright position while the lid is removed.**
- 3. Depress and hold top end of pipette, place pipette into urine and slowly release top allowing urine to travel up into the pipette.
- 4. Place tip of the pipette into tube and depress top to allow urine to flow into tube.
- 5. Carefully fill to between minimum and maximum level shown in photo below.
- 6. Screw the cap on securely and invert the tube 3 to 4 times to ensure it is well mixed.
- 7. Pour remainder of urine from collection dish into the toilet, discard the dish and pipette into the rubbish.
- 8. Label the tube with your name and date of birth.
- 9. Place tube into Biohazard bag and laboratory request form into outside pocket on bag.
- 10. Transport to the laboratory as soon as possible



Check your sample is labelled with your full name and date of birth.
